3<sup>rd</sup> Training Workshop in Monitoring of Recruitment of Fish, Corals and Lobster Akumal, México, 4-7 April, 2006

#### **Summary Report**

The 2006 Training Workshop on monitoring of recruitment was scheduled and run from 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2006 at Akumal, México, where we made use of the facilities and able logistic support of Centro Écologico Akumal. Accommodation was arranged for all participants at the adjacent Hotel Club Akumal Caribe, meal plans were arranged with local restaurants, and the Akumal Dive Center provided diving support services. We thank CEA for the effectiveness of the logistic arrangements for the workshop.

The training workshop was implemented by an instructor team comprising Dr. Mark Butler, Old Dominion University, Dr. Bret S. Danilowicz, Georgia Southern University, Dr. Ken Lindeman, Environmental Defense, Dr. Peter Sale, UNU-INWEH & University of Windsor, Dr. Robert Steneck, University of Maine, and Mr. Paolo Usseglio, University of Windsor. Dr. Ernesto Arias, CINVESTAV, Merida, Mexico, who is a co-investigator in the project, was unable to attend because of a prior commitment in Australia. The workshop was conducted primarily in English, with translation provided by Mr. Usseglio. Written materials were in English and Spanish.
